

WHERE ARE THEY NOW?

The giant, colourful, artist decorated Larkin Toads, Amy Johnson Moths and Puffins Galore! are firmly embedded in the cultural life of the East Riding of Yorkshire and Hull. This booklet shows the locations of all the sculptures which remain on public view with kind permission of their owners. Many others still exist but are currently in private locations.

Although these animal sculpture projects were only planned to last a few months, their durability means that some have now been on public display for over 13 years! We invite you to take the opportunity to see them in their new homes, whether for the first time, or to rediscover these joyful sculptures.

We have done our best to ensure all the information is correct, but from time to time the owners of the sculptures may need to move them for their own reasons.

LARKIN WITH TOADS

Larkin with Toads was the first of our large scale, mass participation public art events, populating Hull and the East Riding with 40 enormous, decorated toads, during summer 2010. The project was part of Larkin25, a six month festival commemorating the life and work of the poet, novelist, librarian and jazz critic, Philip Larkin, marking the 25th anniversary of his death.

The project took Philip Larkin's poems Toads and Toads Revisited as a starting point, poems that take a darkly comic look at the pressures and pleasures of working life. In the first poem, Larkin compares work to a Toad squatting on his life, returning to the theme in Toads Revisited to reflect on his more positive

feelings towards work in later life. Initially controversial, Larkin's Toads quickly won public support, brightening up working days and holidays for visitors and residents alike.

A MOTH FOR AMY

As part of the Amy Johnson Festival of the Arts & Engineering in 2016, A Moth for Amy helped to mark the 75th Anniversary of this Hull hero's tragic and untimely death and bring her remarkable life to the attention of people across the city, the region, the country and the world! The festival celebrated this wonderful woman and her amazing achievements through a wide ranging programme of events.

A Moth for Amy saw 59 decorated moths appear on walls and pavements across Hull, East Riding of Yorkshire, and some key locations across England – University of Sheffield where she studied, The London Science Museum where her plane 'Jason' is displayed, and Herne Bay overlooking

the Thames Estuary where she died. A sixtieth moth, 'Stop me and buy one', was added in 2020.

PUFFINS GALORE!

In 2022 Puffins Galore! was commissioned by East Riding of Yorkshire Council with major support from the Yorkshire Coast Business Improvement District with the aim of harnessing the power of Puffins to increase tourism along the East Yorkshire coast. The 42 artist-decorated Puffins proved a big draw for visitors to the coast and to inland locations too. Besides their colourful appearance along seaside promenades, the Puffins also drew attention to important issues of climate change, endangered wildlife, and to stories of the East Yorkshire Coast.

At the end of each project, the Toads, Moths and Puffins were either bought by the businesses which sponsored them, or were sold at auction with the proceeds going to support local charities and arts projects. Almost £250,000 has now been raised in this way.






